#### **Rail stations**

The closest station to the venue is St Albans City station, which is around a 7 minute walk away. To walk to the Quaker Meeting House from the station, walk along Victoria Street and take the second turning on the right onto Upper Lattimore Road. The venue is on the left hand side of the road.

#### **Buses**

The 84 and 305 stop just outside Upper Lattimore Road and both can be taken either from St Albans City station or from the town centre.

#### **Parking**

There is a car park along Victoria Street between Upper Marlborough Road and Bricket Road. There is also parking available at St Albans City station. Please be aware that these are not free and hourly charges apply.
