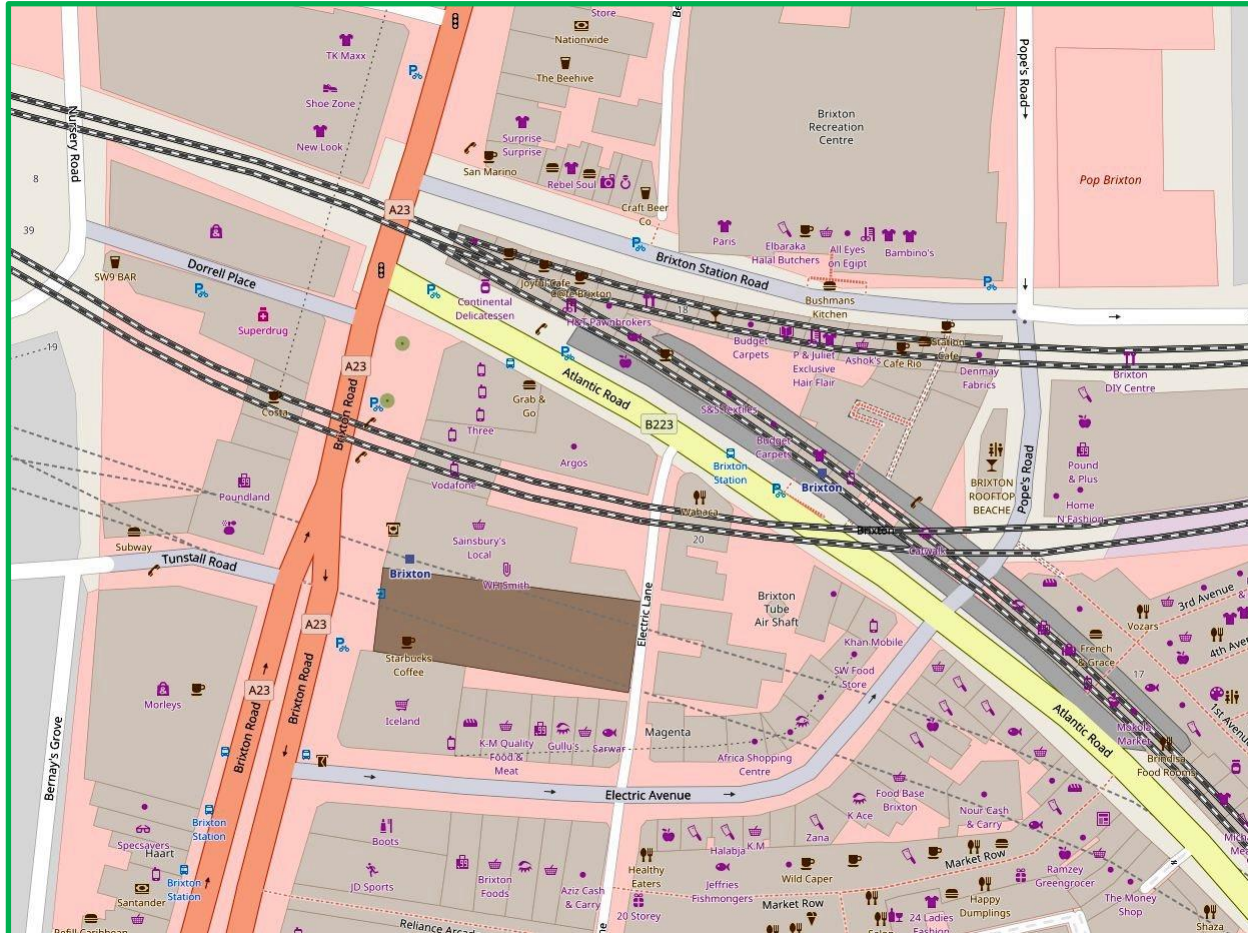

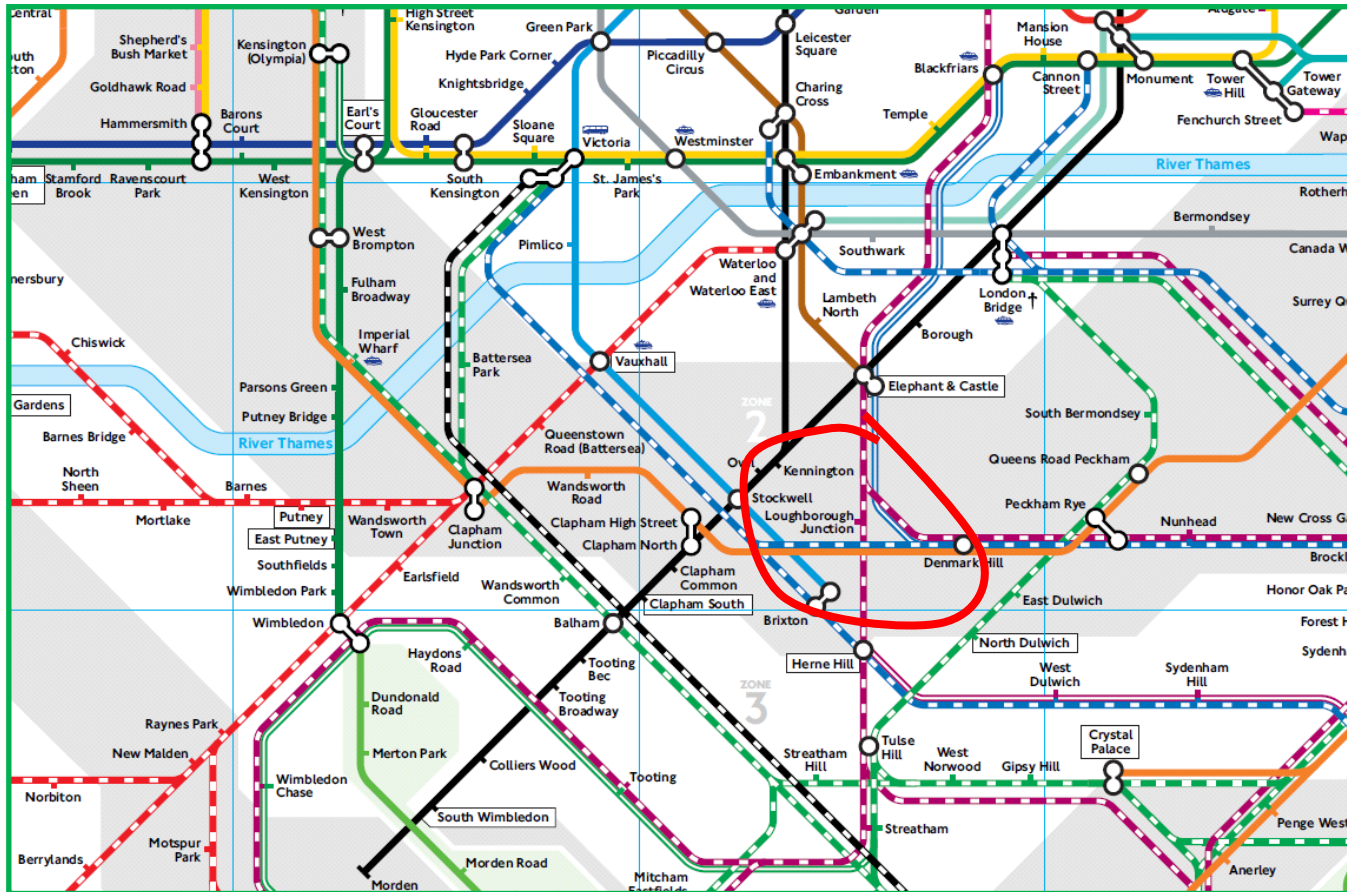

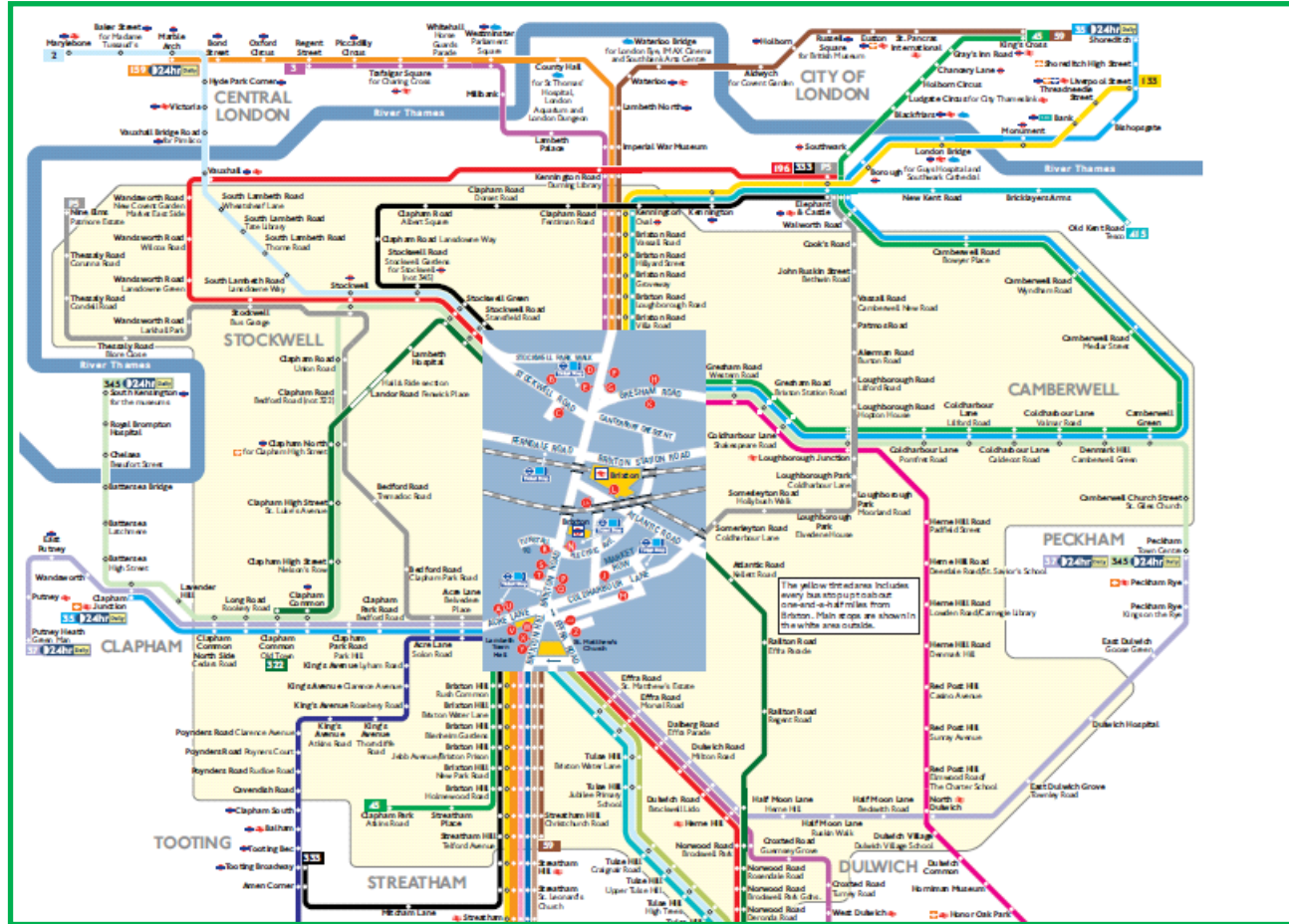

Existing journey opportunities



- Brixton is the southernmost terminus of the Victoria Line
- London's busiest bus stops, the area is served by 20 bus services
- National Rail services between Victoria station via Brixton station to Bromley South and towards Orpington. Many travellers change at Brixton to join the Victoria line.

Potential interchange opportunities

London Overground between Clapham Junction and Dalston Junction stations

Journey examples today, Brixton to:

Brixton to:	Distance	Quickest alternative	Bus alternative
Denmark Hill	2Km	Bus then rail: 21min.	Two buses: 36min.
Peckham Rye	3Km	Bus then rail: 30min.	One bus: 38min.
Clapham Junction station	3km	Underground, walk, then rail: 21min.	One bus: 33min.

London Overground between Clapham Junction and Dalston Junction stations
