Passenger issues in North West Surrey and the Thames Valley

5 Legal powers

- 5.1. Section 248 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 places upon London TravelWatch (as the London Transport Users Committee) a duty to consider - and where it appears to the Committee to be desirable, to make recommendations with respect to - any matter affecting the functions of the Greater London Authority or Transport for London which relate to transport (other than of freight).
- 5.2. Section 252A of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 places a duty upon London TravelWatch (as the London Transport Users Committee) to keep under review matters affecting the interests of the public in relation to railway passenger and station services provided wholly or partly within the London railway area, and to make representations about them to such persons as it thinks appropriate.
- 5.3. Section 228 of the Transport Act 2000 places a duty upon London TravelWatch (as the London Transport Users Committee) to keep under review matters affecting the public in relation to railway passenger services and station services, and to make representations about them to such persons as it thinks appropriate.
