Section 252A of the same Act (as amended by Schedule 6 of the Railways Act 2005) places a similar duty upon the Committee to keep under review matters affecting the interests of the public in relation to railway passenger and station services provided wholly or partly within the London railway area, and to make representations about them to such persons as it thinks appropriate.

Countdown Project – Briefing note

6 September 2011

Transport for London (TfL) would like to update you on the progress of the new Countdown system. Countdown will deliver bus real time information (RTI) for every one of the 19,000 bus stops and 700 routes in London via the internet and text messaging on mobile phones. This will be complemented by 2,500 new on-street Countdown signs.

Following a review by the Mayor, the bus stops planned to receive new on-street Countdown signs have been revised to ensure that no stop that currently has a Countdown sign will lose the facility.

All boroughs will continue to receive the same overall number of on-street signs that has previously been agreed with TfL, but the location of these signs will now change in line with the change of Mayoral policy.

Boroughs receiving additional signs will continue to have these placed in the previously agreed locations that provide the most benefit to the greatest number of passengers.

For boroughs with no increase in signs above their current allocation the list shows the new signs replacing existing ones in their current locations (n.b. signs temporarily removed for operational reasons are included in this list). For Boroughs receiving additional signs, the list shows new signs replacing existing installations plus additional signs allocated as previously agreed with each borough.

As a result of these changes, TfL expect to be able to provide bus RTI via mobile phone text message and the internet by early October 2011. The rollout of the new generation on-street Countdown signs is now expected to commence towards the end of 2011.

Scheduled rollout – The rollout of new Countdown signs will commence towards the end of 2011 and will be completed by late 2012. During the Olympics, rollout will be suspended; however installation of signs will take into account the importance of the games and the increased passenger demand at key locations.

Our installation teams will install signs with two teams working across London in postcode order. This plan ensures that deployment is achieved in the shortest possible time with an efficient use of resources.

In addition to the scheduled rollout, TfL will need to continue to remove some existing on-street Countdown signs for operational purposes, such as power failures, shelter upgrades or communication line failures. These signs will continue to be reinstalled as soon as possible.
